The course design is amazing. It gives students chance to practice more and earn the credits.

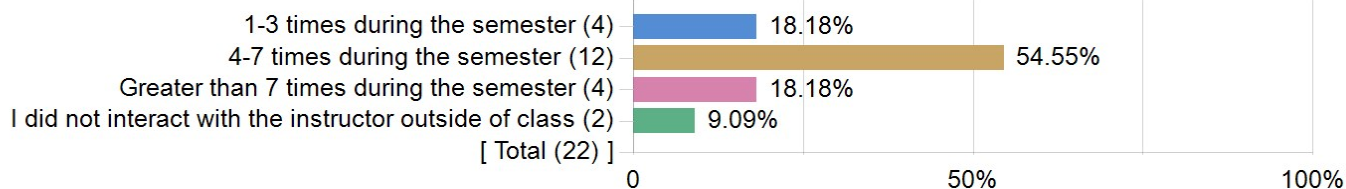

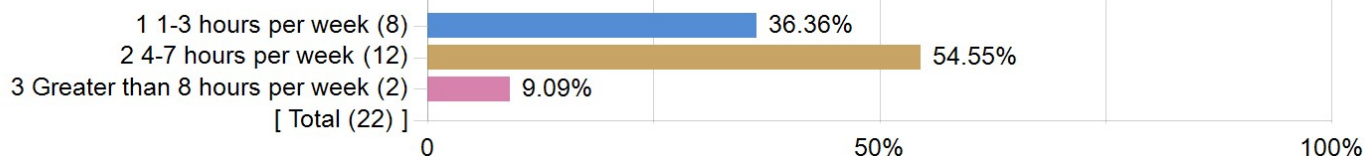

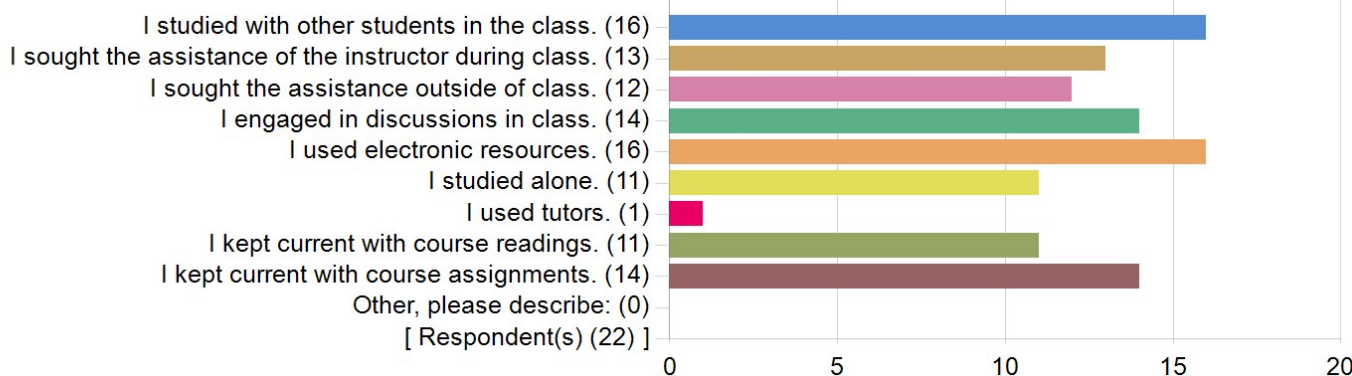
